

**Dear Landfill Customers,**

**Due to the ongoing struggles we are having with the collections of unpaid invoices, the McKenzie County Board of County Commissioners has made a policy decision not to offer credit to anyone that does not meet specific and detailed standards. The McKenzie County landfill is an Enterprise Fund meaning we do not receive tax revenues of any kind. This policy is designed to protect the County from any losses in the future.**

**We totally understand that most of our customers pay their bills on time and that this policy will force some of you to change your accounting and payment methods. I apologize for this inconvenience. We would rather focus on serving you better than focus on the collection of unpaid invoices.**

**As of May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015, any company wishing to have or continue an account will need to fill out the Credit Application and meet the specific and detailed criteria within. Checks (In State Only) and credit cards will still be accepted with the proper forms of ID. Cash is also accepted although we do not have the change on site to deal with large bills.**
