

We will no longer accept cables of any kind here at the landfill. It is damaging our equipment. If you have cable it will be loaded back onto your truck and you will remove it from the pit. You will be subject to the \$240 metal fee (State) and a \$100 loader fee (County) if we assist you.

Barrels of any kind MUST be cut in half or have the top removed. This is required to show us that there are no liquids in the barrel (Guideline 42). People are being injured by chemicals. If these barrels (Poly / steel) are not cut in half nor had the tops removed you will be subject to a \$150 fee. These barrels will be loaded back onto your truck and removed from the pit. If we use our front end loader to assist we will also charge the \$100 loader fee.

All buckets MUST have the lids removed. Again, we need to be able to see that there are no liquids in the containers (Guideline 42). Buckets that do not have the lids removed are subject to a \$25 fee. There will also be a \$100 loader fee if we assist with our front end loader.
