Passport Renewal: Form DS-82

To qualify for this process:

- Have recent U.S. passport to submit with application and passport is not significantly damaged
- Was at least 16 years old when recent U.S. passport was issued
- U.S. passport was issued less than 15 years ago
- U.S. passport was valid for 10 years

Form can also be used for:

- Have U.S. passport book or card and would like to get the other passport option
- Name change and U.S. passport has been issued over one year

Form available at our office or can print one-sided from website, travel.state.gov

Include with form:

- Most recent U.S. passport book or card
- Certified copy of marriage certificate or court order if your name has changed
- Recent Photo -
 - McKenzie County Farmer Newspaper on Main St.
 Call for appointment 701.842.2351. Take photo one day and pickup photo the next day
 - CVS Pharmacy or Walmart
- Make sure you sign your name and enter date on front page of form
- Check or money order for fees (see below)
- Take all to Post Office and mail: flat rate priority mail or flat rate priority express mail

Application Status

If you applied in person or renewed by mail, <u>check your passport application status online</u>. Status updates may not be available until 2 weeks **after** you submit your application.

To Track Application Status

Go to Website: **travel.state.gov** Click "Get a US Passport"

Click "Track My Application Status" on right side of page

Status – "Not Found" means has not been scanned yet

"Not Available" means scanned but not processed

"In Process" means reviewing

"Mailed" means completed and mailed to you

I received my passport and have waited over 8 weeks but have not received my supporting documents. What should I do?

It may take 8 weeks after you receive your new passport for your supporting documents (e.g. birth certificate or previous passport) to arrive. If you have been waiting more than 8 weeks, contact the National Passport Information Center at $\underline{1-877-487-2778}$ to report that you have not received your documents.

My passport was "Mailed" but I have not received it.

If you have waited over two weeks since the date we updated your application status to "Mailed" and you have not received your passport, contact the <u>National Passport Information Center</u>. Customer service representatives will help you complete a special form (known as the <u>DS-86 form</u>) which is a signed statement that you didn't receive your U.S. passport.

You have 90 days from the date your passport was issued to complete the DS-86 form. After 90 days, you must reapply and pay all fees.
