

4.10 REGULATION OF FRESHWATER DEPOTS, PIPELINES, AND PONDS

The conditions of approval of a Freshwater Storage Pond Reclamation Bond Waiver, must meet at a minimum the following:

(11	For Freshwater Storage Ponds, the requirements of subsections (8), (9), and (10) may be waived			
	if, along with the application, the applicant submits written consents of all persons with a record			
	interest in the ownership of the surface of the land where the project is located. Such written			
	consents shall include acknowledgement from the Planning and Zoning Department that they			
understand the implications of the waiver to them. The Board of County Commissioners shall each request for a waiver individually and determine whether a waiver is appropriate in the circumstances. No waiver may be granted unless:				
	A. The applicant demonstrates that all landowners entitled to notice of the application have been specifically notified of the waiver requestinitial			
	B. The liner of the pond, if any, will have a service life of no less than 20 years initial			
	C. The applicant and owners of the land sign an agreement to indemnify and hold harmless the County			
	of McKenzie and all of its agents, departments, successor and assigns for all claims, liabilities, costs,			
	and attorney fees arising from or related to the pond initial
